LASSO

Provides support for:

- The implementation of the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), including stakeholder engagement and family engagement (Priority 3).
- The implementation of local indicators and self-reflection tools
- Reporting local indicators in the California School Dashboard

LCAP Revision

In partnership with the State Board of Education (SBE), the California Department of Education (CDE) is engaged in a process for redesigning the LCAP.



Survey

- The CDE developed a survey to solicit feedback from stakeholders regarding the draft LCAP template and related instructions.
- The survey will be available from October 9, 2019 through November 1, 2019.

Roll Out

- Anticipate beginning template roll out subsequent to the approval of the LCAP template
- Implementing a broad based approach that includes county offices and stakeholders
- Address stakeholder and family engagement requirements within the template

Revised Self-Reflection Tool for Priority 3

- LASSO is also supporting the implementation of the self-reflection tool for the local indicator for Priority 3.
- The self-reflection tool was approved by the SBE at the [March 2019 meeting](#) based on current research, statute, state and federal guidance documents, and the recommendations of the Ad Hoc Family Engagement Workgroup

Revised Self-Reflection Tool for Priority 3

The Ad Hoc Family Engagement Workgroup:

- Included representatives from LEAs, schools, advocacy groups, and the Department. Many of the representatives had multiple roles. Some members are also a part of this group.
- Utilized a process that sought to develop relationship and conditions necessary for collaborative work.
- Reviewed research, best practices, and literature regarding possible challenges/barriers in the area of family engagement.
- Helped to design the revised self-reflection tool

Revised Self-Reflection Tool for Priority 3

The Ad Hoc Family Engagement Workgroup worked collaboratively to:

- Support the adoption of the self-reflection tool and the need for continued support for the development of dual capacity around family engagement
- Form strong partnerships with each other and continue to find ways to support family engagement

Ad Hoc Family Engagement Workgroup

Subsequent to the adoption of the self-reflection tool, members have been instrumental in increasing awareness about the tool and in supporting implementation. For example, there have been presentations at the following venues:

- National Family and Community Engagement Conference in Reno, Nevada
- MTSS Professional Learning Institute in Long Beach, California
- Region 1, PTA meeting, in Pasadena

Moving forward, the Department will be partnering with San Bernardino County Office of Education to present at the National ESEA Conference (Now ESSA) in Atlanta, Georgia.
