

"Students have to Maslow before they can Bloom."

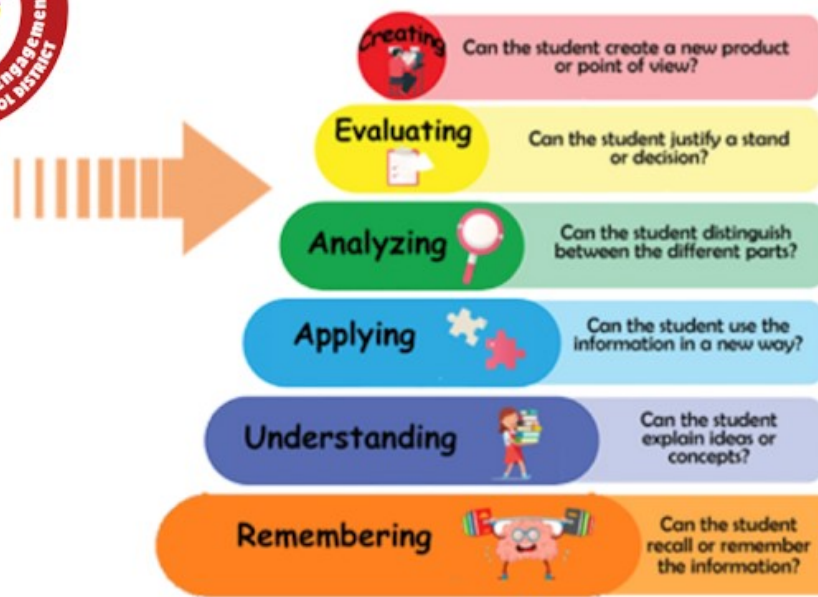
