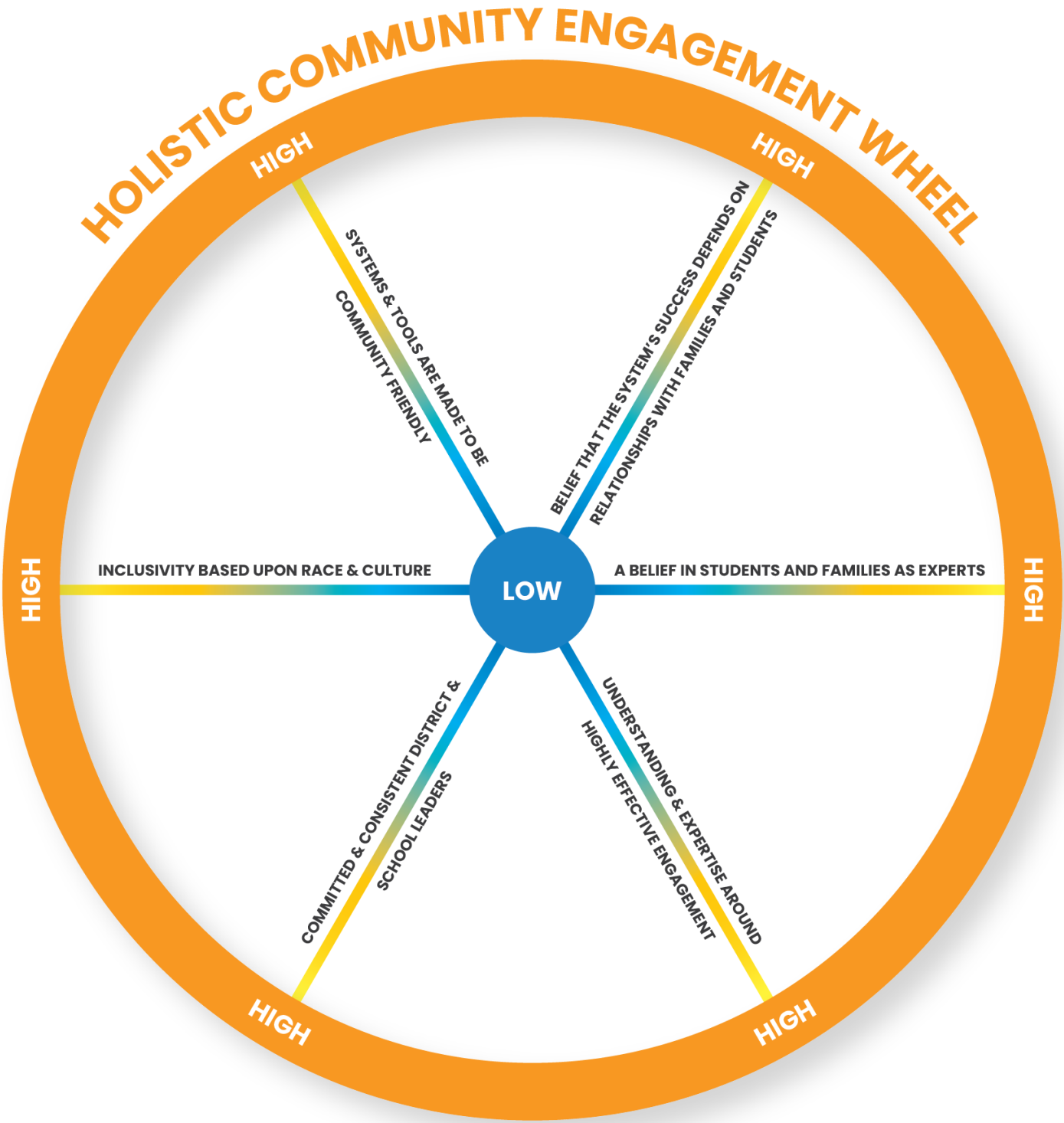


# CEI Holistic Community Engagement Wheel

For each Root, list the evidence for your point placement on the Holistic Community Engagement Wheel. Evidence should include examples and descriptions of strategies, activities, and initiatives. For low implementation points, evidence may include strategies, activities, or resources that are missing or lacking.
